RoHS is a European standard for manufacturing that includes "the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment". In detail, the RoHS bans any new electrical equipment that contains more than the agreed to levels of lead, cadmium, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyl (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE). The RoHS directive and regulations came into force on July 1, 2006.

"As an internationally known audio company with many employees who personally embrace 'green' living standards, we felt it was important for our manufacturing standards to comply with this directive," said Duke Ducoff, SoundTube's Director of Sales. "Our engineering and component purchasing teams have worked very hard over the past couple years to make this happen. We are truly proud to announce this landmark achievement."
